What's it all about?

There are a number of prominent companies based in North Bristol, most of them internationally recognised aerospace companies. These are supported by a strong supply chain of smaller local manufacturing companies.

This is a big and stable industry in this area, and although it isn't predicted to grow as much as some sectors, it is likely to remain an important area of employment.

It is predicted that the area of research in natural science and engineering is set to grow by over 20%.

What can I expect to earn?

For engineering positions you could expect to earn between £30-49k.

For Manufacture and Technicians you could expect to earn between £20-29k.
